

The bar chart below shows Canada's total risk scores in 4 domains: (1) Business Interactions with Government, (2) Anti-Bribery Laws and Enforcement (3) Government and Civil Service Transparency and (4) Capacity for Civil Society Oversight. The four domain scores are weighted and combined and a risk penalty is added for individual domain scores that exceed the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain, and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery.

- **1. Business Interactions with Government**: Canada scores 25 on this measure, indicating low risk of intensive interaction with the government, low regulatory burden, and a low expectation of bribes.
- 2. Anti-Bribery Laws and Enforcement: Canada's score of 22 is low.
- **3. Government and Civil Service Transparency**: Canada's score of 20 indicates a good quality of administration and governmental transparency.
- **4.** Capacity for Civil Society Oversight: Canada's score of 9 suggests a very low risk.
