



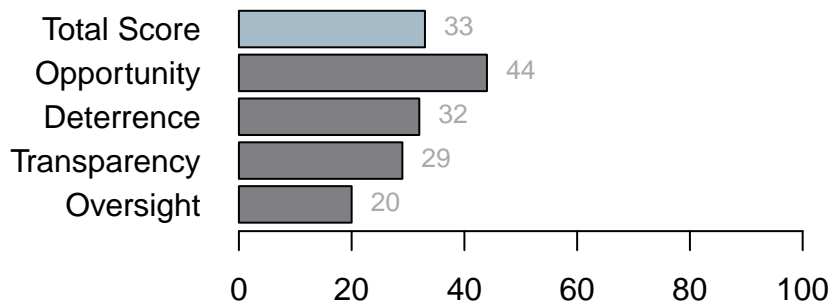
# Andorra

**Overall Risk Score: 33**

**Risk Level: low**

This score is a composite of the four domain scores discussed below, which are weighted and combined to produce the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery. Assessments of whether a given domain score is “good” or “poor” are made relative to all other jurisdictions within that domain.

- 1. Business Interactions with Government:** Andorra has no data for this domain. It receives a good score of 44 based on a gradient-boosting imputation algorithm.
- 2. Anti-bribery Deterrence and Enforcement:** Andorra receives a good score of 32 in this domain, based on a high quality of anti-bribery dissuasion.
- 3. Government and Civil Service Transparency:** Andorra receives a good score of 29 in this domain, based on good governmental transparency.
- 4. Capacity for Civil Society Oversight:** Andorra receives a good score of 20 in this domain, based on a high degree of media freedom/quality and a high degree of civil society engagement.



## TRACE Bribery Risk Typology: Smaller democracy with strong civil society

This group can be described as democratic, stable states with strong civil society and smaller economies.
