


Antigua and Barbuda

Overall Risk Score: 44

Risk Level: medium

This score is a composite of the four domain scores discussed below, which are weighted and combined to produce the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery. Assessments of whether a given domain score is "good" or "poor" are made relative to all other jurisdictions within that domain.

- 1. **Business Interactions with Government:** Antigua and Barbuda receives a medium score of 51 in this domain, based on a high degree of government interaction, a low expectation of bribes, and a medium regulatory burden.
- 2. **Anti-bribery Deterrence and Enforcement:** Antigua and Barbuda receives a poor score of 55 in this domain, based on a low quality of anti-bribery dissuasion and a medium quality of anti-bribery enforcement.
- 3. **Government and Civil Service Transparency:** Antigua and Barbuda receives a medium score of 40 in this domain, based on medium governmental transparency and good transparency of financial interests.
- Capacity for Civil Society Oversight: Antigua and Barbuda receives a good score of 30 in this domain, based on a high degree of media freedom/quality and a medium degree of civil society engagement.

This group is typified by stable democratic government and an economy largely built on the export of a limited number of simple products.
