



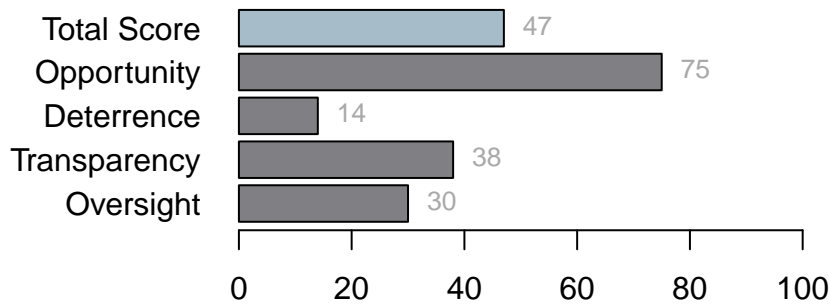

Overall Risk Score: 47

Risk Level: medium

This score is a composite of the four domain scores discussed below, which are weighted and combined to produce the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery. Assessments of whether a given domain score is “good” or “poor” are made relative to all other jurisdictions within that domain.

- 1. Business Interactions with Government:** Macau receives a poor score of 75 in this domain, based on a high degree of government interaction.
- 2. Anti-bribery Deterrence and Enforcement:** Macau has no data for this domain. It receives a very good score of 14 based on a gradient-boosting imputation algorithm.
- 3. Government and Civil Service Transparency:** Macau has no data for this domain. It receives a good score of 38 based on a gradient-boosting imputation algorithm.
- 4. Capacity for Civil Society Oversight:** Macau has no data for this domain. It receives a good score of 30 based on a gradient-boosting imputation algorithm.
