



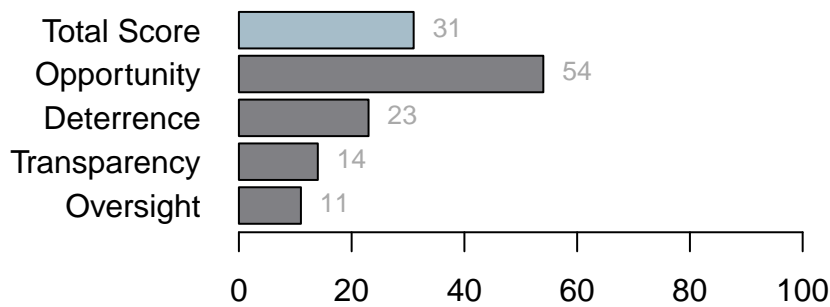

Overall Risk Score: 31

Risk Level: low

This score is a composite of the four domain scores discussed below, which are weighted and combined to produce the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery. Assessments of whether a given domain score is “good” or “poor” are made relative to all other jurisdictions within that domain.

1. **Business Interactions with Government:** Monaco has no data for this domain. It receives a medium score of 54 based on a gradient-boosting imputation algorithm.
2. **Anti-bribery Deterrence and Enforcement:** Monaco has no data for this domain. It receives a good score of 23 based on a gradient-boosting imputation algorithm.
3. **Government and Civil Service Transparency:** Monaco receives a very good score of 14 in this domain, based on very good governmental transparency.
4. **Capacity for Civil Society Oversight:** Monaco receives a good score of 11 in this domain, based on a high degree of media freedom/quality.



TRACE Bribery Risk Typology:

Smaller democracy with strong civil society

This group can be described as democratic, stable states with strong civil society and smaller economies.
