



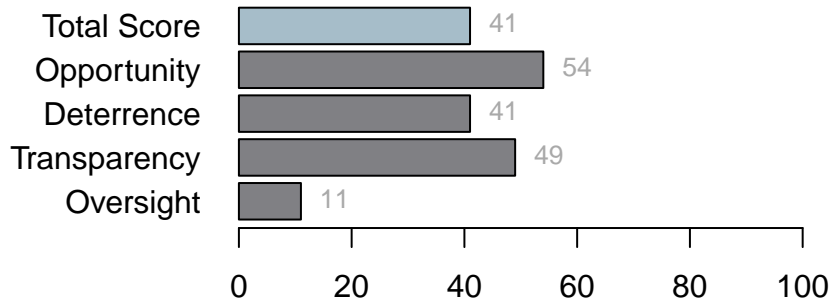
Puerto Rico

Overall Risk Score: 41

Risk Level: low

This score is a composite of the four domain scores discussed below, which are weighted and combined to produce the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery. Assessments of whether a given domain score is “good” or “poor” are made relative to all other jurisdictions within that domain.

- 1. Business Interactions with Government:** Puerto Rico receives a medium score of 54 in this domain, based on a medium degree of government interaction, a medium expectation of bribes, and a medium regulatory burden.
- 2. Anti-bribery Deterrence and Enforcement:** Puerto Rico receives a medium score of 41 in this domain, based on a medium quality of anti-bribery dissuasion and a medium quality of anti-bribery enforcement.
- 3. Government and Civil Service Transparency:** Puerto Rico receives a medium score of 49 in this domain, based on medium governmental transparency.
- 4. Capacity for Civil Society Oversight:** Puerto Rico receives a good score of 11 in this domain, based on a high degree of media freedom/quality.



TRACE Bribery Risk Typology: Smaller democracy with strong civil society

This group can be described as democratic, stable states with strong civil society and smaller economies.
